

#### Current Public Health Use Cases

- Communicable disease investigation/management
- Negative test results- only positives in WEDSS
- Contact Tracing- most up to date contact info
- Med reconciliations
- Care plans for SSI members
- Coordination with advanced care
- Coordination with ADRCs
- Overdose and suicide fatality reviews
- Public Health x WIC- Iron, height, weight

## Future Public Health Opportunities

- COVID lessons learned: Improved integration with DHS databases
  - Wisconsin Immunization Registry Lead (WIR)
  - Wisconsin Electronic Disease Surveillance System (WEDSS)
  - EMResource (HERC data)
- With enhanced analytic capabilities:
  - Local and statewide disease surveillance in real-time
  - Population health analytics
  - Program evaluation, grant reporting
- Auto-refer to disease-specific programs (diabetes, cancer...)
- Shared Master Patient Indexing (MPI)
- Road to Public Health 2.0- public/private sector HIE
- Break down public sector HIE silos across Wisconsin
  - Local and Statewide- Public Health, Medicaid, EMS, BH, Corrections, ARDCs

## **Future SDoH Opportunities**

- Breaking down health and social sector data silos:
  - Homelessness Management Information System (HMIS)
  - Medicaid renewals + unwinding
  - Non-emergency medical transport (MTM)
  - WIC + Foodshare
  - SDoH Screening and referral data
    - Existing WISHIN connections
    - United Way Wisconsin Information & Referral Exchange (WIRE)
    - Local CIEs (<u>IMPACT Connect</u>)
- Current: MKE County Housing Navigation notifications with real-time WISHIN data on hospital encounters
